Jesus Prays for Me

John 17:6-16

Having someone pray for you is one of the most encouraging experiences as a Christian. Something special happens in your heart. We need to pray not only FOR one another, we need to pray WITH one another. The Bible tells us that before Jesus was crucified He prayed for His disciples. That includes us today.

Robert McCheyne once said this: "If I could hear Christ praying for me in the next room, I would not fear a million enemies. Yet distance makes no difference. He is praying for me."

That's what I love about Jesus. He prays for us. Let's read a prayer of Jesus from John 17:1, 6-19. He prayed that we would ...

1. ... Sense the Glory of God. Verse 22

a) Glory means splendor, power and radiance.

Glory means the visible manifestation of the splendor, power and radiance of God. Something is different and unique about being part of God's people. It is exciting, powerful, and dynamic.

b) God's presence lifts people.

Whenever God's presence comes down within the church it lifts up the people spiritually.

c) Jesus adds value to churches.

A church's value is not in the facility, pastor or the programs. The church has value because Jesus is in them.

2. ... Follow the Word of God. Verse 8

When we receive God Word it gives our lives meaning, motivation, and mission. When we continually study, and learn scripture, we begin to change. Jesus desires that His Word would have its proper place in the life of the church. True revival in the church won't happen without the right attitude towards the Word of God. A constant battle rages in churches to get people to care enough about the Bible to read it, study it, and apply it to their lives.

a) Equips the messenger .

1 Thessalonians 2:13

b) Empowers the message .

2 Timothy 3:16-17

c) Affects all men .

John 12:32

Romans 10:13-14, 17

Isaiah 55:11

Acts 2:42

3. ... Obey the Mission of God. Verses 14-19

Jesus said that this sanctification comes by "the truth," God's Word (Ephesians 5:25-27).

a) Jesus asks for sanctification .

Jesus asked God to sanctify us so we could go out into the world. Sanctify means to be set apart and equipped for a special mission. The mission is to bring the good news to the lost so that they might be saved.

b) Sanctify means set apart and equipped .

So if sanctify means "to set apart," then the Father has "sets us apart" from the world of unbelief through His sovereign elective foreknowledge (Romans 8:29, 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14). We are to set ourselves apart from the world by living a godly and holy life (2 Corinthians 6:17).

c) The mission is our priority .

God's people, unified in love and believing in a common goal, can accomplish anything. Jesus wants to set us apart together that we might together carry out the work of the Kingdom of God. Satan loves to keep the body of Christ divided. That keeps us from reaching God's ultimate desire for us.

4. ... Experience the Joy of God. Verse 13

What gives the church, a body of believer's joy? It is our obedience to God in these things. When Adoniram Judson arrived as a missionary in Burma he was known simply for his joy in the Lord. He arrived in Burma and not knowing the language he simply approached a man and embraced him. The man went home and reported to his family that he had seen an angel. From this encounter Adoniram Judson became known as Mr. Glory Face.

a) Our Source of Joy.

"My joy" (John 17:13) refers to a state of bliss or complete happiness that only Jesus can give. It includes the full and free pardon of sin now; the unfailing promise of His presence throughout our lives; and the assurance of a home in heaven hereafter.

The fulfillment of this joy is expressed in I Peter 1:3-9.

b) The Fullness of Joy.

Jesus prays that the church might experience true joy beyond anything the world can give. This joy comes from knowing that glory of God that comes from when we are united together under the authority of the Word of God and obediently going out in the mission of God. It is not laughter or amusement or being entertained but something far beyond that (Nehemiah 8:10). The Bible speaks of an unspeakable, abundant, exceeding, constant, everlasting Joy in the life of believers. It is joy in all circumstances, in sorrow, in trials, in persecution and calamities (1 Thessalonians 5:16, Acts 2:46-47).

Paul says that Joy is a fruit that grows. It comes from knowing the truth, living the truth and being in the midst of the awe of God's continual working. We may have this joy by living in the truth of God's word in every aspect of life.

Conclusion

Jesus prays for us and we should pray for each other in these ways.

- 1) Sense the awe of God
- 2) Follow the Word of God
- 3) Be Obedient to the mission of God
- 4) Experience the full joy of God.
