One Size Fits All

One pastor tells of going shopping for his wife with their youngest daughter. It wasn't easy for him to shop for her because he didn't really know what his wife wanted and the daughter was too young to really help. They thought they had found the perfect gift: a nightgown. Who can't use a nightgown? It's an every day necessity. This one was very easy. It had a tag on it that said *One Size Fits All*. When his wife opened it up, that tag was right. It would *fit all!* It was big enough for him and her both, their daughter, and at least three other children all at the same time!

The point is simply this: if there ever was a gift that was given that is so large, and so great, that one size truly fits all it's the gift of eternal life. The gift of the forgiveness of sins, the gift of salvation that comes through Jesus Christ our Lord is just the right size for all who repent and believe.

The late pastor Jack Hyles once wrote that, "When the average person thinks of eternal life, the first thing that would enter into his mind is endless life. Certainly endless life is included in eternal life, but there is far more than endlessness to eternal life. It is not only endless, but it is boundless. It ... [is] not just long continuation; it means life all the way on, all the way back, all the way up and all the way down ... Eternal life is more than duration or longevity. It is also a quality of life ... It is living now in the always ... What a wonderful thing is eternal life ... It is boundless, but not only will we have it forever; it is a quality of life that we have now."

When Dr. H.A. Ironside pastored the Moody Church in Chicago, he would often say, "We ask God's people to give generously. If you are not a believer in Jesus Christ, we do not ask you to give. We have a gift for you - eternal life through faith in Christ!"

Benjamin Franklin has often been quoted as saying, "In this world, nothing is certain but death and taxes." Many have figured out ways to get out of paying taxes, legal or otherwise, but no one has yet been able to avoid the certainty of death. Sooner or later you are going to experience the pain that comes along with death. You will assuredly lose loved ones by swift tragic loss, the slow progression of disease or just the process of aging. You also will face your own death in one of these ways. But if you are a born again Christian, you need not fear death, for Christ took the sting of it on Himself when He died on the cross for your sins. Jesus has words of comfort to all who will accept Him as Savior and Lord.

The Bible teaches six truths about heaven. They are: 1) Heaven is a real place; 2) Heaven is a permanent place; 3) Heaven is a personal place; 4) Heaven is a holy place; 5) Heaven is for those who are born again; and 6) Heaven is a place of reunion.
