Witnessing with Boldness

John 7:10-18

Our life should be a living witness but we haven't fully completed our witness until we open our mouth and speak. That is hard, but necessary. Here are some very practical Biblical suggestions.

1. Ask for the Spirit's Filling .

Peter, on the night Jesus was betrayed, followed the procession as far as the house of the high priest, but then warmed himself at the fire. People recognized him and tried to point him out, but he denied 3 times that he was a follower of Jesus. The last time he even added curse words for emphasis. By Acts 4:13 the Bible says Peter spoke boldly. What made the difference by Acts 4? It was the Acts 2 experience. He was filled with The Spirit.

Being filled is not a complicated thing. It means being controlled. If you took a sharp axe and used the handle to cut down the tree instead of the sharp edge on the head of the axe. You would get nowhere. The Holy Spirit is the cutting edge. His presence not only gets someone's attention, they'll sense you know what you're talking about, and they can't keep from listening. The Holy Spirit brings conviction, something you and I cannot successfully do.

2. Pray about Your Fear .

Psalms 34:4: "I sought the Lord, and he heard me, and delivered me from all my fears." We know we are to pray according to God's will. Sometimes we're not sure if it's His will and so we say, only if it's your will, Lord. But there are some things we know are God's will. It is His will that people are saved. It is His will that we receive His wisdom in any circumstance. It is His will that our fear would be replaced with faith.

3. Memorize a Gospel Presentation .

Memorize a good soul-winning plan. These five facts should be included in any gospel presentation. We should practice this often with each other.

A. God loves all people. (John 3:16)

B. All people are sinners. (Romans 3:23)

C. Sin has a debt. (Romans 6:23)

D. Jesus paid for your sins. (Romans 5:8)

E. Trust Jesus as your Savior. (Romans 10:13)

4. Claim God's Presence as You Go.

Claim God's promise from Matthew 28:19-20, the Great Commission. You are not alone. He's never more with you than when you make His last command your first concern. He left us here, didn't take us on to heaven, so we can bring others to Himself. He plants us in specific places for a purpose. What's God's purpose for you in your job? It's not to complete the assigned task but simply to support you in your real job which is soul winning. All you do on the job are simply the things you do to earn a living. Your real job is to share the Gospel so people around you have the opportunity to receive Christ. All those daily tasks can get us down, but when we look at the possibilities, just having the opportunity to share our faith makes going to work all the more worthwhile.

5. Do Not Fear Mistakes .

Don't be afraid of making mistakes. The biggest mistake is not saying the wrong thing. The biggest mistake is saying nothing. God will still use your witness even if you make a mistake. He blesses your obedience of trying. It is not about you. You cannot save them. But God can, and when you open your mouth, He'll fill it. But He cannot use your silence. A good example of this is found in John 1:45-49.

God does His best work in spite of us. A preacher and wife were going home from church one Sunday. He really felt like he had hit a home run that morning. "Fishing" for a compliment, he asked her, "Honey, how many truly great preachers do you think there are in this world?" She replied, "Honestly, I'd estimate there's about one less than you think."

Conclusion

Pray for boldness in your witnessing. Pray for divine appointments. Get out your calendar and write it on there, first thing in the morning, that you will look for opportunities to share your faith every day. If you don't schedule it, it will not even be an option.

Will we stand up for righteousness, exalt virtuous living and proclaim the Truth to a lost an dying world? I believe that we have the character and resolve to "rebuild the ancient ruins;...raise up the age-old foundations;...be called the repairer of the breach, the restorer of the streets in which to dwell" (Isaiah 58:12). WE have lost our way. We have forgotten our past. We are not without hope, however, for we still have access to the truth of our past and to God's Word that never fails. Therefore, let us remove the cobwebs from our national memory and shine forth the light of God's Hand in our history.
