## ***Thanks, and Keep Praying!***

By the time you read this, the SJBA Mission Team will already be in Yankton preparing for a week of service. Thank you for helping make it possible. You allowed us to use the church van for the week. While the old thing may have some years on it, it still functions well and is greatly appreciated. Thanks for your food gifts for the trip and VBS. Each will be used to help feed us and serve a church and a community. There are lost folks in South Dakota just like in Saint Joseph. By supporting this trip you are helping to see that Jesus is proclaimed and the love of Christ is shared. Thanks for paying our trip fees. Your offerings and gifts and sacrifices are making a difference on all levels.

But most of all, thanks for your continued prayers. By petitioning the heart of God in our behalf, you are making yourselves a part of the mission. Someone said, "Many of us cannot reach the mission fields on our feet, but we can reach them on our knees. Solid lasting missionary work is accomplished by prayer, whether offered in China, India, or the United States."

Recently I read a story about missionaries Bill and Molly Thompson. The Thompson's, along with missionaries Lewis and Sally Morley felt led to go to a large city in Columbia, South America, to start a work. They rented a storefront and prepared to fight opposition as they had other places they had attempted to minister. Instead a great revival broke out. As they testified to God's moving they were told about a man who had come before them 18 years earlier. Even though the man did not speak Spanish, he rented an apartment on the same block and fasted and prayed for souls for 18 years. He was an intercessor, not a preacher. He never had a convert. He only prayed and fasted for 18 years. He died on the mission field just days before the two missionary couples arrived. He was a great success because he labored in prayer.

A Norwegian missionary, Marie Monsen served in China in the 1950s. She testified to the intervention of angels when Christians were in great danger. The Christians had taken refuge in the mission compound only to be surrounded by looting soldiers. Within minutes, they were astonished to find that the soldiers had all left in peace. A few days later the hostile men explained that they were ready to break down the flimsy wall when they noticed tall soldiers with shining faces on a high roof in the compound. Marie Monsen wrote, "The heathen saw them, it was a testimony to them, but they were invisible to us."

We don't know what all we might see on this trip, but I am confident we will see prayers answered and the Gospel proclaimed and lives changed. The fervent prayers of a righteous man avails much.

It was Phillips Brooks who said, "Pray the largest prayers. You cannot think a prayer so large that God in answering it, will not wish you had made it larger. Pray not for crutches but for wings!"
