So she called the local Poison Control Center and asked them if she could still use the sauce or if they thought it was bad. They told her to just boil the sauce again and everything would be all right.

Well, that night, while all of her guests were enjoying a wonderful spaghetti dinner, the phone rang. The guest who was sitting closest to the phone volunteered to answer it. With a strange look on her face, the guest said to Becky, "It's the Poison Control Center. They want to know how the spaghetti sauce turned out."

My guess is that was the last time those folks ate at Becky's house. We've all experienced embarrassing moments in our lives at one time or another. The fact of the matter is there are times when embarrassing moments happen that we just can't help. But there are other times when we find ourselves in embarrassing situations because we've done something stupid or because we've put ourselves in a situation where there's a great chance for embarrassment and shame.

Regardless of how embarrassing a situation you've been involved in, whether it was your fault or there was nothing you could do about it, God can still work through you. God doesn't just know us. He doesn't just speak to us and give us freedom. He also works through us. As a matter of fact, He can work through anyone.

Throughout the book of Judges we read about Israel finding herself in trouble time and time again. Israel would be overrun by a neighboring nation or people and find herself in bondage. And then they would cry out to God for help. And God, in His mercy, would send along a person to lead the Israelites back to freedom.

Samson was one of these guys chosen by God to bring freedom to His people. And God

worked through Samson in a unique way. An angel told Samson's parents that they were going to have a special son who would bring freedom to Israel. The angel told them to make sure they didn't cut Samson's hair. Well, they didn't and Samson became known as a great warrior that God worked through. Unfortunately, Samson had a weakness for a woman named Delilah. She pressured him until he revealed the source of his strength. She cut his hair and God removed His hand of blessing from his life. Reduced to a common slave Samson wondered, "Can God ever work through me again?"

Maybe that's a question you've had about yourself. Maybe you look at your past and you think, "I don't know if God can work through me. I've done some pretty rotten stuff." And most of us have done some pretty rotten stuff. I have as well. But amazingly God desires to work through you and He can. That is, if we will connect to Him and step out in faith. Are you willing? God is ready.
