Are You Willing?

One of the great women of faith in our Southern Baptist history was a lady named Bertha Smith. Bertha was a missionary to China and her focus was spiritual renewal, filling, and living in the spirit. She led Christians of her day to the prayer closet. In one of her books, which speak about repentance, she tells about going to a church to lead a weeklong "Christian Life Conference." During the conference she would have the people attending to "write out their list of sins." Her Scriptural text was Isaiah 58:1 (of course in those days, it would have been Noah Webster's Bible -1822). One of the reasons we don't repent of our sin is because we don't face our sin. Like Isaiah, Miss Bertha called people to list or face their own sin.

Can you do that today? Would you be willing to do that today? Miss Bertha tells the story of asking one lady if she had listed her sin and the lady responded, "Yes, I have. I have twelve sins." In her book, Miss Bertha said, "I thought she was letting herself off kind of light." So Miss Bertha began to quiz the lady about areas of her life and when quizzed the lady feel under the conviction of the Holy Spirit. One of God's great invitations is for God's people, who are walking in sin and are not convicted about their sin to turn and face their sin and allow the Spirit of God to do, within them, His work of conviction.

Only then will there be repentance, which leads to restoration, which leads to renewal, which leads to revival. Then Miss Bertha had them to pray over their sins. When you pray over something, you become diligent, zealous, and earnest about it.

God's invitation to realize whose you are and what you need naturally leads to the invitation to repent. Can you make a list of your sins? More to the point, "WILL" you make a list of your sins? Jesus is calling today, will you listen, hear, ignore, or take His next invitation.

Scientists studied a native tribe in South America whose people have been dying

prematurely for generations. After thorough investigation, the cause of premature death was determined. The disease was transmitted by an insect that lived in the walls of their adobe homes. This new information presented several options. They could move to another area where such insects don't exist, tear down their homes and rebuild them, use insecticide to rid their homes of the bugs, or, continue as they had for generations and continue to die early. Surprisingly, these people opted to remain as they are and do nothing about their problem.

Many people behave similarly. To save themselves, they know what they must do; instead, they opt to remain unchanged. What about you? Are you willing to be honest about your sin, list it, and allow God to work within you? Repentance, restoration, renewal, revival: It's as simple as that if we want to be change agents for our world.
