Gratitude Expressed

Last Sunday Pastor Appreciation month came early at our church. While your love offering (\$900 of surprises!) for our upcoming adventure did catch us a little off guard, I'm not sure I expressed my full gratitude to all of you in that moment. Ellen and I do feel truly blessed to serve the Lord with this amazing body of believers here in this small part of the world. It has been nearly 30 years filled with mostly joy, some sorrows and griefs, and many challenges as we seek God's guidance and attempt to obey His calling. We can only hope we have made a small contribution in chasing out the darkness of Saint Joseph.

Gratitude is a noun. It is the "feeling of being thankful to somebody for doing something." Gratitude takes on three forms: a feeling in the heart, an expression in words, and a giving in return. It is from the word gratitude that we get gratefulness. The need for an attitude of

gratitude has been mentioned many times. As we mature with this attitude and develop, gratitude blossoms into thanksgiving. And for the believer, thanksgiving is part of our very nature; in fact we should be practicing thanks-living (Colossians 2:6-7). What in the world do we have to be thankful for?

1. Salvation. God has provided a piece of armor - the helmet - to protect my head and keep my mind from being infiltrated by diseased thinking. As a man thinks in his heart, so is he and my thoughts can only stay on course when I stay in a redeemed mindset. The most important thing I have is the condition of my soul, knowing that if I die today, I am with the Lord.

2. The Body of Christ. God cares so much about my life and what happens to me that He has surround me by a great cloud of witnesses, some are already victorious and some are going through the fire as I am. He said that He would never leave me or forsake me, and still He provides me with a support system to cover me with prayer, walk with me through the valleys and celebrate with me on the mountaintop (Colossians 3:14-16).

3. Forgiveness. The baggage of guilt and pain does not have to travel into tomorrow with me. I can cast my burdens upon Him because He really cares about me. I can forgive those that have hurt me and I can keep my communication with Christ in prayer unhindered. Forgiveness releases me from the hurt and increases my ability to heal (Psalms 30:11-13).

4. Hope. There is strength given to me that confidently expect the absolute best to come into my life because of Christ living in my heart. What destroys others does not damage me. This amazing hope is the anchor that stabilizes me when the seas are rough and waves start to crash in around me (Hebrews 12:27-29).

5. Family. The Bible promises good things to me as I honor my mother and father and enjoy the gift of my life with those whom God has provided. Children are a treasure from the Lord and should be treated as such. And our two grandsons are little precious souls just waiting to learn the truths of God and His Word. What a great challenge!

6. My Faith. The Bible calls it substance, the substance of all things hoped for (substantial). It's the faith in me that pleases God. It's my victory to overcome the world. It's the evidence I have that what is unseen right now will one day be visible. Faith in God enables me to believe and trust in family, to hope for my future, to forgive others unconditionally; to fellowship with the Body of Christ and faith is how I received the gift of salvation.

Is this life filled with some bad things? The answer is yes. But with gratitude, thankfulness abounds towards God. Remember what He has already done for you. I thank God for you!
