Thanks to those who filled in for us. Brenda and George, Martha and Mike are always ready to help out in children's Sunday School when Ellen is absent. You folks are the best and we appreciate your faithfulness. Bro. Jack is a true servant of the Lord and we are blessed to have you and Flo as a part of our fellowship. I'm confident in how the Lord uses him to proclaim His word. Bro. Roger and Pam are also a blessing. Be sure to thank them for their willingness to lead worship and fill in while Bro. Romey and I are in revival. It is a good opportunity for you all to get to know them a little better and worship together before the Lord.

I'm sure you are all anxious to hear about our pilgrimage to Israel. While some places and experiences might have had more meaning at the moment, it's so hard to determine what might be classified as "our favorite part." After landing in Tel Aviv, we briefly visited the ancient city of Joppa (a part of Tel Aviv) where Jonah went to the Mediterranean seaport and caught a boat traveling in the opposite direction of Nineveh. Then while on our way up the coast to the city of Nazareth for our first night, we got caught in a traffic jam and it was late when we finally got to bed. It wasn't until morning that we realized our hotel was right on the beach. We traveled on up the coast to Caesarea Maritima where Herod the Great built his city. It's also known for Herod's Aqueduct system. And we were told Bibi has a house there where he spends most of his time (you know, Netanyahu, the Israeli Prime Minister).

We visited Nazareth and saw several things, including the ancient Synagogue where it's believed Jesus read from the prophet Isaiah and even the hill the people might have tried to throw him off. Then we moved across the valley to the Sea of Galilee, where we spent the night at Tiberius. The boat ride on the Sea of Galilee was calm, extremely peaceful and

soothing. Perhaps it's because we weren't doing any walking at the time. Standing on the original slab of the south gate of the Temple in Jerusalem was pretty special as well, knowing that it is the one place you can be certain Jesus really did walk. Praying on the Mount of Olives surrounded by ancient olive trees (one is said to be over 2,000 years old) was pretty special. Seeing the caves of Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered has a certain mystique to it, especially after visiting the Shrine of the Book in Jerusalem where some of the manuscripts, both papyrus and copper, are displayed. And being part of a baptismal ceremony in the Jordan River was also memorable.

Seeing the various sites where many things *might* have happened was meaningful and sometimes hard to keep straight. It may take us several weeks to get things organized in our minds. We're talking 2,000 to 3,000 years of history to try and sort out instead of only 300-400 years tops in our nation. But when we are ready, we are willing to share with you as much as we can. While you might not ever be able to take that journey, we will do our best to try to enhance your Biblical understanding as well.
