## **What Do We Know?**

Just because you've never been to the Holy Land, doesn't mean you don't know much about it. We study about it and its rich Biblical history every time we read our Bible. All we need to do is to mention certain stories and our minds immediately recall the facts of the story, including the characters, where it took place, and just how God was intervening in that particular part of history. Just because Ellen and I were there recently doesn't mean we know more than you. It just means we were there recently.

We all know what a difference it makes when we engage all our senses in learning. When we see, hear, touch, or even taste something, we have a greater understanding of experience. So, today, as we share with you all, that is our desire: To be able to help you see, hear, touch (somehow), and experience the Holy Land in such a way that you know it a little better.

Personally, I never had much urge to go in the past. Sure, I thought it would be neat, but also knew it was expensive. You all know how tight Ellen and I are so we never spend that much on travel, vacation, etc. Gosh, we never even spend that much on a car! But when the opportunity came, and after much prayer, we believed that if we were ever to go, now would

be the time. And with the Lord's prompting, we decided to go.

It's obvious such a pilgrimage doesn't make one any holier. If anything, I feel wearier and less refreshed since returning. It is a hard trip, and we've expressed just how much walking there is, and how intense the journey is, that it isn't for the faint of heart (or foot). It certainly isn't meant to make you more spiritual, even though it does allow one to gain a better grasp on spiritual things. For us, it is simply a way for us to share with others our experience in order that they might experience it, too.

There's an old story about a businessman who was notorious for his ruthlessness. He announced to Mark Twain, "Before I die, I mean to make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. I will climb Mount Sinai and read the Ten Commandments aloud at the top." "I have a better idea," said Twain. "You could stay home in Boston and keep them."

Well, after making the trip, I'm not sure which one would be easier. There's more of a challenge to keeping the Ten Commandments than reading them, no matter where you are. We're in the process of studying the Ten Commandments on Sunday nights. Perhaps you'll be led to come and join in. It's a lot cheaper than a trip to the Holy Land, and Mount Sinai, and I doubt it will tire you out near as much. And, I promise, you won't have to worry about jet lag!
